The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met on February 14, 2018 at 7:30 P.M. Board members present were: Lamar Glatfelter, Bob Gladfelter and Charlie Van Scoyoc. Others present were: Attorney Herrold, April & Dave Rehbein, Kim & Joe Roberts, Steve & Carolyn Bupp, Phillip Baer and Brian Kaltreider.

The meeting opened with the pledge to the flag.

The minutes were approved as presented.

Attorney Herrold presented Ordinance 18-01, off road vehicle ordinance. Carolyn Bupp asked if this ordinance only allows for 30 minutes of recreational riding. Attorney Herrold explained if someone can hear the noise on their property they could report the people. Charlie made a motion to adopt Ordinance 18-01, seconded by Bob. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Carolyn Bupp asked if the Board would consider waiving the fee for a Zoning Hearing if they need to go for a waiver for the issue with the subdivision of the farms. Lamar said he is not in favor of waiving the fee.

Bob stated he left a message with Mr. Fisher. Mr. Fisher left a message with Bob that he has hired an Attorney.

Attorney stated that no proposal has been submitted to the Township. Attorney Hoffmeyer, Attorney McNeal, Samuel Fisher & Steve & Carolyn Bupp need to come to the Township with a proposal. Waiving the fee for the zoning hearing could be part of the proposal.

Bob asked Attorney Herrold to contact both Attorneys to get an update.

The bills were presented to the Board. Bob made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Charlie. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.
