The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met on August 8, 2018 at 7:30 PM. Board members present were: Lamar Glatfelter, Bob Gladfelter and Charlie Van Scoyoc. Others present were: April Rehbein, Donald Bubb, Steve Forbes, Steve & Carolyn Bupp, Brian Kaltreider. Attorney John Herrold, Attorney Andrew Herrold and Dave Reed.

The meeting opened with the pledge to the flag.

April Rehbein & Carolyn Bupp are recording the meeting.

The minutes were approved as presented.

Dave Reed was present representing the Jefferson Codorus Joint Sewer Authority. Dave would like to thank the Board for helping the Sewer Authority with the refinancing. Dave also would like to request that the Supervisors allow the Sewer Authority to review the Hills at Valley View plan before it is approved. The Supervisors agree that this can be done.

Steve Forbes presented pictures from the flooding that has been going on for the last 6 years at his property. Every heavy rain the water comes down from the Friedman property and floods his basement. Attorney Herrold will look into this issue and see if there is anything that can be done by the Township.

Cathy Bury on Trump Road is concerned that her neighbor is blowing grass out onto the roadway. The Township cannot enforce this problem but can try sending a letter asking the neighbor not to throw grass out onto the road.

Attorney Herrold reported that Samuel Fisher was fined \$50.00 by the magistrate for violation of the stray animal ordinance. He has 30 days to pay the fine.

Bob Gladfelter reported that the International Dump truck has a clogged EGR coolers. The repair cost will be \$5,400.00.

The bills were presented to the Board. Bob made a motion to pay the bills. Charlie seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Snyder Mill Road will be paved tomorrow.
