The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met on July 11, 2018 at 7:30 PM. Board members present were: Lamar Glatfelter, Bob Gladfelter and Charlie Van Scoyoc. Others present were: April Rehbein, Steve & Carolyn Bupp, Brian Kaltreider and Attorney John Herrold.

The meeting opened with the pledge to the flag.

The minutes were approved as presented.

Brian Kaltreider asked for an update on the Hillandale plan. Attorney stated that Hillandale has submitted their plan. The Supervisors granted a 90-day extension on the plan at the July 5th meeting.

Steve Bupp asked why Roser Road is closed. Bob said there is still some work to be done on the road. The road crew will be working there off and on.

Attorney Herrold reported that a complaint has been filed against Mr. Fisher for violation of the stray animal ordinance. A hearing with the District Magistrate has been set for August 18, 2018.

Attorney Herrold also reported that he has not found any pending legislation that amends the High Tunnel statute that was recently passed.

Steve Bupp commented that he has not been able to get anything moving with the subdivision issues with Mr. Fisher.

The bills were presented to the Board. Bob made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Bob. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.
