The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met on May 9, 2018 at 7:30 PM. Board members present were: Lamar Glatfelter, Bob Gladfelter and Charlie Van Scoyoc. Others present were: Attorney John Herrold, April Rehbein, Steve & Carolyn Bupp, Kim & Joe Roberts.

The meeting opened with the pledge to the flag.

The minutes were approved as presented.

April Rehbein & Carolyn Bupp are recording the meeting.

Under public comments Carolyn Bupp commented that she has a processing permit. Eric Swiger told her she must produce records by December 31, 2018. When she meets with Eric she will be discussing that she has a cut flower operation and that this is an agricultural operation. She is using less than 5 acres for of land for this use.

The bid opening for road material was opened at 8:00 AM today. The aggregate bids were as follows:

The Board would like to try using ¼” stone as opposed to ½” stone on the seal coating. Since the ¼” stone is not PennDOT approved the stone would need to be paid for from the General Fund. Hammaker East is willing to send two separate bills.

The Board would also like for Attorney Herrold to send Hammaker East a letter putting them on notice that we have had problems with their work the past two years, if there are problems this year the Board will not consider them for future work.

The Board has decided that the fog seal will not be necessary.

Charlie made a motion to award the bid to Hammaker East without the fog seal. Bob seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.
