The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met on November 1, 2018 at 7:30 PM. Board members present were: Lamar Glatfelter and Charlie Van Scoyoc. Others present were: April Rehbein and Steve & Carolyn Bupp.

The meeting opened with the pledge to the flag.

The minutes were approved as presented.

Carolyn Bupp is recording the meeting.

Carolyn asked the Board if they would consider lifting the preventive remedies on their property without taking it to the Zoning Hearing Board. They would like to be able to obtain permits to do work on their building. Lamar stated the Supervisors will talk to Attorney Herrold at the next meeting.

Carolyn also had concerns about the subdivision on Brenneman Road. She stated that Antony Lopiccolo was issued a permit for a road into a field. She also had questions about the event permit that issued to the Hillclimb.

The Junk yard license for Clair Amspacher was presented. Charlie made a motion to sign the license, seconded by Lamar. The motion carried. Vote 2-0.

Bob Gladfelter left a written report regarding his meeting with Eric Jordan from the York County Conservation District. Bob & Eric met the Friedman property and found the field to be permanently stabilized without any active erosion. The access drive has been vegetated and permanently stabilized with only some minor erosion. Charlie made a motion to accept this report. Lamar seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 2-0.

The bills were presented to the Board. Lamar made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Charlie. The motion carried. Vote 2-0.
