The meeting opened with the pledge to the flag.

The minutes were approved as presented.

Terry White presented the peacekeeping agreement for the Tax Collector sittings. Terry said he is also available to enforce Township Ordinances. He can take people to the Magistrate that are violating the Township Ordinances. Bob made a motion to sign the agreement. Charlie seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 3-0. The annual audit letter was presented to the Board. Charlie made a motion to sign the letter, seconded by Bob. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

A letter was received from Attorney Stacy MacNeal's office granting an extension of time for the Bupp/Fisher plan till February 28, 2021. Bob made a motion to accept the extension. Charlie seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Mark & Jeff Powers called into the meeting by phone. They would like to have some amenities at the development such as an all-purpose field, pavilion or gazebo and possibly a tot lot. They probably cannot do all three. They will need their engineer to see what is possible. They are requesting that the recreation fees be adjusted to deduct the cost of these amenities. Mark & Jeff will work with their engineer and get back to the Board on February 10, 2021.

Bob Gladfelter talked to the Board concerning possibly abandoning Parrish Road and Brenneman Road. Brandon Wright said he does not own all the properties on Brenneman Road. Brandon said he would be interested in entering into a maintenance agreement with the Township.

The bills were presented to the Board. Bob made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Charlie. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.
