The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met on May 13, 2021 at 7:30 PM. Board members present were: Lamar Glatfelter, Bob Gladfelter and Charlie Van Scoyoc. Others present were: April Rehbein, Attorney Andrew Herrold, Brandon Wright, John Amspacher, Steve & Carolyn Bupp and Kim Roberts.

The meeting opened with the pledge to the flag.

The minutes were approved as presented.

April Rehbein & Carolyn Bupp are recording the meeting.

The Markel/ Thomas subdivision plan was presented to the board for final approval. Bob made a motion to sign and approve the plan. Charlie seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 3-0

Carolyn Bupp asked what the process would be to place a weight limit on Roser Road and Brenneman Road. Carolyn said both roads are being used for heavy truck and heavy equipment. Bob Gladfelter will check in with the Township engineer. Bob also commented that the maintenance on both of these roads has not been out of the ordinary.

Attorney Herrold talked about the off-road vehicle ordinance. Bob commented that it is not an enforceable ordinance. Bob would like to revisit this ordinance at a later time and make some changes.

Attorney Herrold informed the Board that the Township will be eligible for money from the American Recovery Relief Fund. The money can only be used on specific items such as extending broadband and cable.

The bids for road materials were opened and read on April 20, 2021 as follows:

For 2650 Tons Binder Course Buffalo Valley Rd. Kinsley bid 75.00 per ton, Stewart & Tate bid 78.10 per ton and Long's Asphalt bid 77.80 per ton.

For 350 Tons Binder Course Sunny Slope Rd., Kinsley bid 82.00 per ton, Stewart & Tate bid 95.70 per ton and Long's Asphalt bid 87.10 per ton.

Bob made a motion to award the bid to Kinsley Construction. Charlie seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

For 25,555 SY seal coat Russell Standard bid 1.203 per SY, Stewart & Tate bid 1.275 per SY and American Paving Fabrics bid 2.50 per SY.

For 1500 LBS crack seal Russell Standard bid 2.350 per lb., Stewart & Tate bid 2.40 per lb. and American Paving Fabrics bid 4.00 per lb.

Bob made a motion to award the bid to Russell Standard. Charlie seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Bob Gladfelter presented two quotes for a new truck bed. Lancaster Truck Bodies quoted 29,115.00 and MJR Equipment quoted 28,532.13. Bob made a motion to accept the quote from MJR. Lamar seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Bob reported that grading is complete on the dirt roads. Manheim Township would like Codorus to mill approximately 700 ft of road. Bob should find out how much this would cost to be contracted out before giving Manheim a quote.

The bills were presented to the board. Bob made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Lamar. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.
