

July 6, 2017

The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met on July 6, 2017 at 7:30 P.M. Board members present were: Lamar Glatfelter, Bob Gladfelter and Charlie Van Scoyoc. Others present were: April & Dave Rehbein, John Amspacher, Carolyn & Steve Bupp, David Yoder and Steve Brenton.

The minutes were approved as presented.

April Rehbein and Carolyn Bupp are recording the meeting.

Under public comment Steve Brenton commented that he met with Keith Hunnings concerning his application for a driveway permit. Keith said if he gets the driveway down to 5,000 sq. ft. he would not need a stormwater plan. Steve said that he has contacted Keith four times and has not received a return phone call. Keith did apologize.

The Township Emergency Management Plan Promulgation resolution 17-03 was presented to the Board. Bob made a motion to sign the Promulgation, seconded by Charlie. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Bob gave the Roadmaster report. Nafe Sawmill Road has been opened back up. Bob has not heard anything from C.S. Davidson on the Hamme Road project. The road crew will be working on Roser Road next week. The following week work will begin on Cherry Run Rd. & Buffalo Valley Rd. Steve Long will be paving at the beginning of August.

Bob has received a quote from Tri-Boro for a 22 kw generator at a cost of \$4,900. Bob has also received a new quote from Met Ed for placing a pole with a meter at the park at a cost of \$3,196. The Township will need to take the wire underground from the pole to the pavilion and the flag pole.

Cecile Feters contacted the Township and said the Township will need to appoint someone to the Joint Sewer Authority to start serving January 2018. Lamar will contact Tom Insley to see if he would like to come back.

The bills were presented to the Board. Bob made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Charlie. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

The meeting adjourned at 7:55 P.M.
