Lieutenant Palmer from the PA State Police was present to give a yearly report. She reported that since January there have been 61 citations, 19 warning, 46 crashes, 4 DUI crashes, 5 DUI's, 5 drug overdoses, 12 thief's and 6 burglaries. She wanted to make the Township residents aware that the police can do welfare checks when you are away from home. Carolyn Bupp reported that the kids at the Yoder property on Krebs Road are in or near the road a lot of the time. Lieutenant Palmer will contact the family.

Carolyn Bupp said the lane that runs through her property is private. They have had issues with people using this private lane. Carolyn would like a letter from the Township stating that the lane is private. Lamar said the Board will talk to Attorney Herrold next week.

Charlie said he thinks the Board should meet at Kevin Fergusons property to discuss cutting the bank back.

The bills were presented to the Board.
