

August 9, 2017

The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met on August 9, 2017 at 7:30 P.M. Board members present were: Lamar Glatfelter, Bob Gladfelter and Charlie Van Scoyoc. Others present were: April Rehbein, Attorney John Herrold, Brian Kaltreider Steve & Carolyn Bupp and John Amspacher.

The meeting opened with the pledge to the flag.

The minutes were approved as written.

April Rehbein and Carolyn Bupp are recording the meeting.

Resolution #17-03 amending building permit fees was presented to the Board. Bob made a motion to adopt resolution # 17-03, seconded by Charlie. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Attorney Herrold said the Bupp appeal was heard in court last week. Scott Lineberry represented the Township. The Judge will most likely issue a decision in the next 2-3 months.

Attorney gave an update on the Hillandale appeal. The Attorneys have agreed to a 90 day discovery period. They will be taking depositions from Attorney Herrold and the Supervisors.

The Hamme Road construction was discussed. The configuration of the road is going to be changed. Part of the road will need to be abandoned and the new section will need to be adopted.

Bob reported that the paving projects are complete on Buffalo Valley Road and Cherry Run Road.

Carolyn Bupp said she would like to see the Planning Commission review the amusement ordinance. Carolyn said another festival is planned and if it's going under the amusement ordinance just like it was in the spring the way that ordinance is written it should have never opened. Carolyn said the ordinance is outdated. Lamar said the Township is working on this and will not be working on the ordinance at this point. Carolyn asked if the festival can open in the fall under the current ordinance. Lamar stated that we are working on it.

The bills were presented to the Board. Bob made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Charlie. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Steve asked Bob if he has spoken to Eric. Bob said Eric's next step for the barb wire is to take them to court.

The meeting adjourned at 7:55 P.M.
