

June 14, 2017

The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met on June 14, 2017 at 7:30 P.M. Board members present were: Lamar Glatfelter, Bob Gladfelter and Charlie Van Scoyoc. Others present were: April Rehbein, Attorney John Herrold, Steve & Carolyn Bupp, Brian Kaltreider, John Esh.

The meeting opened with the pledge to the flag.

April Rehbein & Carolyn Bupp are recording.

The minutes were approved as presented.

Three ordinances were on the agenda.

Ordinance 17-03 is for no parking on Watertank Road on the east side of the road from the Manheim Township line to the rail road tracks. Bob made a motion to adopt ordinance 17-03. Charlie seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Ordinance 17-04 is for speed limit of 35 mph on Watertank Road and Ridge Road. Bob made a motion to adopt ordinance 17-04. Charlie seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Ordinance 17-05 is an ordinance making some changes to the Zoning Ordinance. Comments have been received from YCPC. The Township planning commission has approved this ordinance. Carolyn Bupp commented that road side stands need to register with the department of agriculture. Carolyn also stated that processing was never discussed at a meeting with the Township planning commission. Lamar said this ordinance was discussed and approved by the planning commission. Charlie made a motion to adopt ordinance 17-06. Bob seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Steve Bupp asked who he needs to see about a barbed wire fence that was placed on the property line of his farm and Samuel Fisher's farm. He said there is a dispute as to where the property line is. He was told to call the Zoning Officer. Steve asked if Bob has been in contact with Mr. Fisher. Steve commented that Mr. Fisher said the Supervisors guaranteed him that a variance would go through. Mr. Fisher said he will not pay for a zoning hearing.

John Esh was present with several other Amish men to discuss the school they would like to build. They typically have a lease agreement with the land owner. If the school discontinues the owner would take the land back over.

Bob gave the road master report. The men have been putting in pipes. Bob is having a hard time finding parts for the 2000 GMC dump truck. Still waiting to hear back from Met Ed about electric at the park. Penn Dot has conducted a traffic study at 516 & Shaffers Church Rd. They will add a 35 mph speed advisory plaque to existing right curve with a left side road warding sign on southbound 516 approaching Shaffers Church Rd. They will also install horse drawn buggy signs between Sticks and Jefferson.

The bills were presented to the Board. Bob made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Charlie. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

The meeting adjourned at 8:45 P.M.
