The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met on June 1, 2017 at 7:30 P.M. Board members present were: Lamar Glatfelter, Charlie VanScoyoc and Bob Gladfelter. Others present were: April Rehbein, Steve & Carolyn Bupp, John Amspacher, Virginia Parker, Virginia Craley, Thomas Heffner, Jim Hunt, Roger Flood, Dale Kurtz, David Dalpezzo.

The meeting opened with the pledge to the flag.

The minutes were approved as presented.

April Rehbein & Carolyn Bupp are recording the meeting.

Under public comments Carolyn Bupp requested that the meetings be posted on Facebook.

The Township has received a request to close the dirt portion of Roser Road. There was a group of Roser Road residents present at the meeting. The Roser Road residents are opposed to closing the road. They said it is impossible for large vehicles such as trucks, farm equipment, emergency vehicles, or horse trailers to come up from Rockville Road. They said it is almost impossible to come up from Rockville when there is snow or ice on the road. The traction is better is on dirt road during bad weather. There was also concern about home owners insurance going up since there would only be one access to the properties.

Bob Gladfelter said the Township has been awarded a dirt road grant for this road. The road will be widened to 16-18' drainage pipes will be installed DSA will be placed on the road. This should help with drainage problems on this road.

The Supervisors have decided based on this meeting that the road will not be closed.

Bob reported that he has heard from Met Ed regarding electric at the park pavilion. They offered two different options with estimates of \$11,000 and \$12,000. The road crew can run the electric from the barn.

Patrick Wright is a traffic engineer. He came down to assist on a traffic study at the corner of S.R. 516 & Stone Church Rd. The sight distance needed is 383' in a car the sight distance to the left was 381' and in a truck or school bus the sight distance to the left was 220'. Bob sent a letter to William Morgan giving him 30 days to trim the trees. If he doesn't respond within 30 days the Township will trim the trees.

Lamar reported that he spoke to three people about dogs running in the park without a leash. This seems to have stopped the problem.

The bills were presented to the Board. Bob made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Charlie. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

The meeting adjourned at 8:25 P.M.
