The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met on May 10, 2017 at 7:30 P.M. Board members present were: Lamar Glatfelter, Bob Gladfelter and Charlie Van Scoyoc. Others present were: April Rehbein, Attorney Herrold, Steve & Carolyn Bupp and David Dalpezzo.

The meeting opened with the pledge to the flag.

The minutes were approved as presented.

April Rehbein & Carolyn Bupp are recording.

The bids were opened and read as follows:

Vulcan Materials was the only bid received for stone:

1. 200 tons anti skid \$12.95 per ton
2. 200 tons AASHTO # 8 (1%) \$12.95 per ton
3. 9000 tons PA-2A subbase \$8.99 per ton
4. 2500 tons AASHTO #57 \$12.95 per ton
5. AASHTO #1 \$12.95 per ton
6. 500 tons Rock Lining R4 \$16.76 per ton
7. 300 tons R-8 Rip Rap \$20.15 per ton
8. 2100 tons DSA \$15.35 per ton

Bob made a motion to award the bid to Vulcan Materials, seconded by Charlie. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

There were three bids for furnishing and placing Superpave Wearing Course.

Stewart & Tate bid:

1. 2400 tons 19mm superpave wearing course \$72.87 per ton for a total of \$174,888.00
2. 2400 SY 19mm superpave wearing course \$14.10 per ton for a total of \$33,432.00

Kinsley Construction bid:

1. 2400 tons 19mm superpave wearing course \$76.40 per ton for a total of \$183,360.00
2. 2400 SY 19mm superpave wearing course \$14.50 per ton for a total of \$34,800.00

Long's Asphalt Inc. bid:

1. 2400 tons 19mm superpave wearing course \$68.30 per ton for a total of \$163,920.00
2. 2400 SY 19mm superpave wearing course \$14.10 per ton for a total of \$33,840.00

Lamar made a motion to award the bid to Long's Asphalt Inc. Charlie seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

There were three bids for placing DSA.

Stewart & Tate bid:

1. 2100 tons DSA \$4.95 per ton for a total of \$10,395.00

Kinsley Construction bid:

1. 2100 tons DSA \$8.50 per ton for a total of \$17,850.00

Long's Asphalt Inc. bid:

1. 2100 tons DSA \$4.80 per ton for a total of \$10,080.00

Charlie made a motion to award the bid to Long's Asphalt Inc. seconded by Lamar. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Three bids were received for Seal Coat & Joint Seal.

Hammaker East bid:

1. 42,000 SY Bituminous Seal Coat \$1.03 per ton for a total of \$43,260.00
2. 2500 LBS Asphalt & joint crack sealing \$2.15 per ton for a total of \$5,375.00

Stewart & Tate bid:

1. 42,000 SY Bituminous Seal Coat \$1.169 per ton for a total of \$49,098.00
2. 2500 LBS Asphalt & joint crack sealing \$1.49 per ton for a total of \$3,725.00

Martin Paving bid:

1. 42,000 SY Bituminous Seal Coat \$1.23 per ton for a total of \$51,660.00
2. 2500 LBS Asphalt & joint crack sealing \$2.50 per ton for a total of \$6,250.00

Bob made a motion to award the bid to Hammaker East. Charlie seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Attorney Herrold will advertise speed limit ordinances, no parking ordinance and the zoning ordinance for the June meeting.

Bob is ordering buggy signs for Shaffers Church Rd.

Bob has put in a request for a traffic study on S.R. 516 near Shaffers Church Rd. Penndot will be doing a study within the next 30 days.

Traffic Engineer Pat Wright will be out on Thursday to conduct a traffic study at the corner of Stone Church Rd. & S.R. 516.

Steve Bupp mentioned that the site distance is bad at the corner of Miller Road & S.R. 516 and also at the corner of Snyder Road & Shaffers Church Rd.

The bills were presented to the Board. Bob made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Charlie. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Bob had a meeting with Met Ed regarding electric at the park. They are looking into several different options.

The meeting adjourned at 8:10 PM.
