

April 6, 2017

The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met on April 6, 2017 at 7:30 P.M. Board members present were: Lamar Glatfelter, Bob Gladfelter and Charlie Van Scoyoc. Others present were: April Rehbein, Brian Baer, Steve & Carolyn Bupp and John Amspacher.

The meeting opened with the pledge to the flag.

The minutes were approved as presented.

Bob Gladfelter spoke to Ray Masimore about a generator to the Township building. The Township could purchase the generator directly from Generac then pay Ray for the installation. Bob will look into the different models and costs.

Bob reported that the Township will be receiving a dirt road grant for Roser Rd. The cost of the project is \$129,000. The Township will receive \$70,000 from the grant and the Township will make up the difference in cost with man power and equipment use.

Bob met with Jeff Shue to discuss making changes to Hamm Rd. & Birthday Club Road. Jeff said that Hamm Rd. will be easy but there could be some problems with Birthday Club Road. Jeff will look into this and get back in touch with Bob.

Bob reported that the Township hosted another class on traffic studies. After the class the instructor went down to the corner of Stone Church Rd. Since the leaves were off the trees there was enough sight distance. They will do another study when the leaves are back on the trees.

Lamar reported that infield mix is needed on the ball diamond. Mulch is needed on the playground and the lines need to be repainted on the parking lot at the park.

Bob reported that the Township has received a call about a building falling onto the road on S.R. 216 near Pierceville Rd. A portion of the building fell off last year. The resident is elderly and cannot afford to have the building removed. Bob will look into this and see what can be done.

Steve Bupp asked why Houcks received a violation notice for not cleaning up the house they burned but others are allowed to let building fall down. Steve said he will get the property cleaned up as soon as the weather permits.

The bills were presented to the Board. Bob made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Charlie. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

The meeting adjourned at 8:10 P.M.
