The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met on May 4, 2017 at 7:30 P.M. Board members present were: Lamar Glatfelter, Bob Gladfelter and Charlie Van Scoyoc. Others present were: April Rehbein, John Amspacher, Steve & Carolyn Bupp and Aaron Stoltzfus.

The meeting opened with the pledge to the flag.

April Rehbein & Carolyn Bupp are recording the meeting.

The minutes were approved as presented.

Aaron Stoltzfus has a contract on Mike Hollins property on Roser Road. Aaron would like to make a request that the Township abandon the dirt portion of this road. He said this portion of road looks like a driveway and the buildings are very close to the road.

Bob said the Township is going to be getting a grant to repair this portion of road but if the road is abandoned the Township would not do the work. A cul-de-sac would be required. A survey would also need to be done. Bob will prepare a letter contacting property owners along this road and have them attend the meeting on June 1st to discuss this further.

Bob, Lamar & Jerry Lucabaugh interviewed Christian Miller for the Solicitor for the Zoning Hearing Board. Lamar made a motion to appoint Christian Miller as the Zoning Hearing Board Attorney. Bob seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

The zoning ordinance amendment was reviewed by YCPC and Codorus Township Planning Commission. Both have recommended that the Supervisors adopt this ordinance. Bob made a motion to advertise the ordinance, seconded by Charlie. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Lamar & Keith Hunnings did an inspection of Spoutwood Farm. Lamar said that everything the Board requested has been addressed. Keith and Lamar will be attending the Fairy Festival to see if they are in compliance with everything.

The bills were presented to the Board. Bob made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Charlie. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

The meeting adjourned at 8:05 P.M.
