

March 8, 2017

The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met on March 8, 2017 at 7:30 P.M. Board members present were: Lamar Glatfelter, Bob Gladfelter and Charlie Van Scoyoc. Others present were: April Rehbein, Attorney Herrold, Steve Nafe, Dave Rehbein, Steve & Carolyn Bupp, John Amspacher and Philip Baer.

The meeting opened with the pledge to the flag.

The minutes were approved as presented.

April Rehbein & Carolyn Bupp are recording the meeting.

Carolyn Bupp stated that she asked for the minutes of a previous meeting to be amended that she did not report that Jason Gross didn't have sign permit. Attorney Herrold explained that the amendment to the minutes was reported in the Feb. 8<sup>th</sup> minutes. Carolyn also asked for a copy of the proposed ordinance that was sent to York County Planning Commission. She was told the proposed ordinance is a draft until it is advertised and is not public record until that time.

Steve Bupp reported that Mr. Fisher couldn't make it to tonight's meeting. Carolyn asked what the next step is for the illegal subdivision. Attorney Herrold said that as stated in the letters that were sent to the Bupp's and Mr. Fisher no permits will be issued until the matter is resolved.

After some discussion Attorney Herrold told Steve & Carolyn they should get a proposal together of what they think is appropriate to address the problem then the Board will look at it.

Kirk McClelland was before the Board to discuss the new driveway he put in on Fair School Rd. Eric Swiger will need to look at the driveway.

Attorney Herrold reported that the Judge heard the appeal for Hillandale. It could take another 3 months to get a decision.

Samuel Fisher called in and joined the meeting on speaker phone. Attorney Herrold told Mr. Fisher they he should get together with Carolyn & Steve Bupp and come to the Township with a proposal. Samuel asked if the original plan from Stanley Bupp would work. Attorney Herrold said that might be a starting point.

The Township would like to sell the Scag mower. The Township will send an ad to the newspaper and also put the mower on Municibid.

Bob discussed making some changes to Hamme Rd.

The bills were presented to the Board. Bob made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Charlie. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.
