

6-2- 2022 Board of Supervisors Meeting

Present were Charlie VanScoyoc, Lamar Glatfelter, Bob Gladfelter Attorney Andy Herrold, and Steve & Carolyn Bupp

The meeting began with a pledge to the flag.

Motion to approve minutes as presented. Motion approved.

Andy called Dan Cohen of the Cohen Law Group. A discussion was had regarding the lack of broadband access across Codorus Township. Bob explained that the TWP has had a hard time working with Comcast to get information on coverage across the Township. Bob would prefer that 60% of any expansion be borne by the company. Dan explained that the current density requirement of the existing cable franchise agreement is 25 homes per linear mile. He said he does not believe Comcast will go below that number. As such, he proposes that the TWP prepare an RFQ and send it to various broadband providers (including Comcast). It would ask for their qualifications to build out a broadband network through the TWP. Upon receipt of the qualifications, the TWP would prepare a legally enforceable agreement regarding the buildout. Board agreed to permit Dan to prepare a proposal for services and work with Andy to present that at the next hearing. There were questions about whether we could do away with Comcast generally and also whether Comcast might pull out of the TWP altogether if we proceed down this route. These questions arose after Dan ended his phone call and Andy will take these back to Dan.

Motion to reappoint John Amspacher and Brenda Miller to another term on the PC. Each has agreed to serve. Motion passed unanimously.

Question about minutes from Carolyn Bupp. Andy explained that the TWP minutes have become more robust in the past year and that he believes they meet the intent of the Sunshine Act.

Andy will be gone next month for National Guard. John will cover.

Motion to pay the bills passed unanimously.

Motion to adjourn.
