The emergency management promulgation was presented to the Board. The emergency management plan was updated. Lamar made a motion to sign the promulgation. Charlie seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 2-0.

A request was received from Powers Homes for a reduction of the letter of credit for the Hills At Valley View. C. S. Davidson has made a recommendation to move forward with the reduction. Charlie made a motion to recommend the reduction. Lamar seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 2-0.

The Board reviewed the deed transfers received from the Recorder of Deeds.

South Central Senior letter sent a thank you letter to the Township for donation that was sent.

A letter was received from Tri-Community Ambulance requesting a larger donation.

Attorney Herrold said the Zoning Hearing Board members can select their own Attorney. Attorney Herrold will try to get proposals from other Attorneys for the position. The Zoning Hearing Board can hold a special meeting to appoint a new Attorney.

The bills were presented to the Board. Charlie made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Lamar. The motion carried. Vote 2-0.
