Carolyn Bupp made a comment that the dimensional requirements in section 505 are not met with the proposed private burial ordinance. Carolyn also commented that she doesn't understand how a private burial ground is an accessory to AG.

Lamar made a motion seconded by Brenda to approve the proposed ordinance to send to the Supervisors. The motion carried. Vote 4-0.
