The acting Chairman <u>Lamar Glatfelter</u> opened the meeting by asking for a nomination for Chairman for the year 2025.

<u>Bob Gladfelter</u> made a motion to nominate <u>Lamar Glatfelter</u> to serve as Chairman for the Year 2025, seconded by <u>Charlie VanScoyoc</u>. Motion carried.

<u>Charlie VanScoyoc</u> made a motion to appoint <u>Bob Gladfelter</u> to serve as Vice-Chairman for the Year 2025, seconded by <u>Lamar Glatfelter</u>. Motion carried.

<u>Bob Gladfelter</u> made a motion to appoint <u>Megan Harris</u> to serve as Secretary-Treasurer for the Year 2025, at a pay rate of \$1,030.00 /week 1/1/2025-2/5/2025 and \$1,080.00 /week 2/6/2025-12/31/2025, and to set the Secretary-Treasurer's bond for 2025 at \$750,000, seconded by appoint <u>Lamar Glatfelter</u>. Motion carried.

<u>Charlie VanScoyoc</u> made a motion to appoint <u>Brandon Maxwell</u> as Road Superintendent/Roadmaster for 2025 at an hourly rate of \$28.84 From 1/1/2025-3/31/2025 and \$29.34 from 4/1/2025 – 12/31/2025, seconded by <u>Lamar Glatfelter</u>. Motion carried.

<u>Bob Gladfelter</u> made a motion that the Road Superintendent be given the authority to recommend any hiring or firing of employees to the Board of Supervisors for final action, seconded by <u>Charlie VanScoyoc</u>. Motion carried.

<u>Charlie VanScoyoc</u> made a motion to give the Road Superintendent the authority to make purchases up to \$1,500 in case of an emergency, seconded by <u>Lamar Glatfelter</u> Motion carried.

<u>Lamar Glatfelter</u> made a motion to re-appoint <u>Charles Aiken</u> as an hourly employee for the year 2025, at an hourly rate of \$26.78 seconded by <u>Bob Gladfelter</u>. Motion carried.

<u>Charlie VanScoyoc</u> made a motion to re-appoint <u>Clark Thoman</u> as an hourly employee for the year 2025 at an hourly rate of \$24.00 From 1/1/2025-3/31/2025 and \$24.50 from 4/1/2025 – 12/31/2025, seconded by <u>Bob Gladfelter</u>. Motion carried.

- Time and one-half for all hours worked more than 40 hours per week or 8 hours per day.
- Health Insurance.
- 2025 IRS Rate of \$.70 per mile for the use of their personal vehicles on Township business
- five (5) days sick leave per year with unused days being forfeited.
- Eleven (11) paid holidays per year (1) New Years Day (2) Good Friday (3) Memorial Day (5) July 5th (5) Labor Day (6) Thanksgiving Day (7) Christmas Day (8) & (9) the two election days and (10) & (11) two floating days of the employees The employee must have scheduled vacation or report to work as scheduled the day before and the day after the holiday in order to receive holiday pay.
- no holiday pay be paid to employees that are on disability.
- to pay full-time regular employees vacation pay as follows:

One year through eight years – two weeks
Eight years through fifteen years- three weeks
After completion of 15 years – four weeks

- Employees working less than the full year will receive pro-rated vacation pay consisting of one twelfth (1/12) of the annual vacation hours for each month worked.
- the difference in Jury Duty pay and their regular pay if the employee is called to serve on jury
- full-time employees three (3) days pay for a death in the immediate family (parent, spouse, child, sister, brother, grandparent or grandchild) and one (1) day for an in-law, Aunt or Uncle

□ New Employees with experience working full time \$23.48
Raises for new employees would be given at intervals of \$.25 @ 3 months, \$.25@ 6 Months and
