Paul Dehoff made a motion to retain Peoples Bank of Glen Rock as banking institution. Motion second by George Smith.

George Smith made a motion to get the secretary's bond from Cappy Thomson Bonding Company. Motion second by Paul Dehoff.

 and part time labor 3 days paid Vacation (Wilmer)

George Smith made a motion to pay the regular men the following paid holidays, New Year's Day, Good Friday - Memorial Day, July 4, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day and Christmas and pay part time help the same if they are working ~~during~~ when the holiday falls. If an emergency should call the men to work, the holiday pay would fall the first day after the emergency. motion second by Ralph Gladfelter
