

January 8, 1976 215

The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors held a regularly scheduled meeting January 8, 1976 at 7:30 P.M. in the Twp. Bldg., Brodheads, Pa.

Present were Board members, Leroy Thoman, Paul Lechoff, Charles Wehly, and ^{the} Secretary, Goldie Day. Others present were representatives from Jefferson Volunteer Fire Co., Lineboro Volunteer Fire Co., Seven Valley Fire Co. & New Freedom Fire Co.. Glen Rock Hose & Ladder did not have a representative as promised.

Charles Wehly, Chairman called the meeting to order.

The Board members and Fire Company representatives worked on the mapping out of sections of the Township to be served by each of the fire companies. Robert Rebert of Jefferson noted that for a structure fire, three companies respond, a field fire, two companies are called and one company is called for an automobile fire. The Board & representatives from the Fire Companies will meet again after the Township has the maps marked and copies made for each company. It was decided to have only two or three companies meet at a time with the Board to set up the names of the roads and intersections.

Leroy Thoman made a motion to sign resolution #1-3 for Donald Kiser's plan which they have presented to D.E.R. This plan had been approved December 29, 1975 by the Board.

Nahlon Stambaugh asked about reimbursement for attendance at schools and meetings which he is required to attend by the State Dept. of Environmental Resources. The Board will find out from the State Association if this can be done.

Mr. Stambaugh also wanted to know

if the percolation tests he performed showed he killed by the Legionnaires the Township in lump pay for the work. The Board also returned him and this will be looked into.

There was a motion by Paul Wehff to retain Mahlon Stambaugh as Acting Sewage Inspector for the Township. Seconded by Leroy Thoman. The motion passed.

Leroy Thoman made a motion to retain Edwin L. Rappoldt as Zoning Officer for 1976, this motion was seconded by Charles Wehly. The motion passed.

The minutes of the December 24 meeting were read and approved.

The Organizational minutes were read and approved.

Leroy Thoman made a motion to increase the pay for hired help by 15¢ per hour over that set at the January organizational meeting. Charles Wehly seconded this motion and the motion passed. This will bring the hourly rate of an equipment operator to \$5.95 per hour and General Labor to \$3.75 per hour.

Paul Wehff made a motion to appoint George Williams to the Township Zoning Hearing Board for a 3-year term, seconded by Leroy Thoman. The motion passed. Mr. Williams' term will end December 31, 1978.

The bills were presented to the Board.

Paul Wehff made a motion to pay the bills seconded by Charles Wehly. The motion passed.
