

The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors, York County, Pa. held their 1976 organizational meeting at 7:30 P.M. January 5, 1976 in the Township Building, R.D. 1, Brodheads, Pa. Present were Leroy A. Thoman, Paul M. Dehoff, & Charles L. Wehrly, members of the Board and Goldie Day, Sec. Treasurer.

The meeting was called to order by the Chairman, Leroy Thoman.

Charles Wehrly made a motion to appoint Paul Dehoff Supervisor to fill the unexpired term of George Smith, seconded by Leroy Thoman. The motion passed.

Paul Dehoff made a motion to appoint Charles L. Wehrly Chairman for 1976, seconded by Leroy Thoman. The motion passed.

Leroy Thoman made a motion to appoint Paul Dehoff vice-Chairman of the Board for 1976, seconded by Charles Wehrly. Motion passed.

Paul Dehoff made a motion to appoint Goldie H. Day Secretary-Treasurer for 1976, seconded by Leroy Thoman. The motion passed.

Paul Dehoff made a motion to appoint Leroy Thoman Roadmaster and Township Superintendent for 1976, seconded by Charles Wehrly. The motion passed.

Leroy Thoman made a motion to appoint Charles Wehrly Roadmaster for 1976, seconded by Paul Dehoff. The motion passed.

Charles Wehrly made a motion to appoint Paul Dehoff roadmaster for 1976, seconded by Leroy Thoman. This motion passed.

Paul Dehoff made a motion to give the Superintendent the right to hire and fire as he sees the need, seconded by Charles Wehrly. The motion passed.

Leroy Thoman made a motion to

retain W. Burg Anstine Solicitor for the Board for 1976, seconded by Paul Dehoff. This motion passed.

Leroy Thoman made a motion to retain Gilbert Malone as Solicitor for the Codorus Township Planning Commission for 1976, seconded by Charles Wehly. Paul Dehoff opposed this motion. The motion passed by majority vote.

Leroy Thoman made a motion to retain the present tax structure for 1976, namely, 9 mills Real Estate Tax with 2 mills set aside for major equipment purchases; \$5.00 per Capita Tax,  $\frac{1}{2}$  of 1% Earned Income Tax and  $\frac{1}{2}$  of 1% Real Estate Transfer Tax. This motion seconded by Paul Dehoff. The motion passed.

Paul Dehoff made a motion to hold the regular monthly meetings the first Thursday of the month at 7:30 P.M. seconded by Charles Wehly. The motion passed.

Paul Dehoff made a motion to give the Superintendent an emergency fund of \$300.00 per month in case of need, seconded by Charles Wehly. The motion passed.

Paul Dehoff made a motion to pay the Secretary-Treasurer  $3\frac{3}{4}\%$  of monies disbursed, seconded by Leroy Thoman. This motion passed.

Paul Dehoff made a motion to retain the Peoples Bank of Glen Rock as the banking institution for 1976, seconded by Charles Wehly. The motion passed.

Paul Dehoff made a motion to have the Secretary-Treasurer's bond written by the H.A. Thomson Company.



seconded by Leroy Thoman. The motion passed. Paul Dehoff made a motion to pay kind help as follows:

① Equipment Operator \$3.80 per hour

② General Labor \$ 3.60 per hour

This motion was seconded by Leroy Thoman. The motion passed.

Leroy Thoman made a motion to pay the regular full time employees 8 paid holidays; ① New Year's Day ② Good Friday ③ Memorial Day ④ July 4th ⑤ Labor Day ⑥ Thanksgiving Day ⑦ Christmas Day, ⑧ 1 floating holiday of the employee's choice and to pay part time help holiday pay if they are working when the holiday falls. Should an emergency arise to require the employee to work on the holiday, the holiday pay would be for the first working day after the emergency has ended. Charles Weekly seconded this motion. The motion passed.

Leroy Thoman made a motion to pay full time employees regularly employed 2 (two) weeks vacation pay and part time help 3 (three) days vacation pay. An employee must work one full year to receive 2 weeks vacation pay; an employee with six months or less would receive 3 days vacation pay. Charles Weekly seconded this motion. The motion passed.

Paul Dehoff made a motion to request the Auditor to set the rate of pay for Supervisors working as Roadmasters at \$4.00 per hour and to grant holiday and vacation pay in line with that paid kind help. Leroy Thoman seconded this motion. The motion passed.

Leroy Thoman made a motion to

retain William E. Sacra Associates as Township Engineer for 1976, seconded by Paul Rehoff. The motion passed.

Paul Rehoff made a motion to ask the Auditors to approve a mileage allowance of 12¢ for Supervisors using their vehicles to haul tools, materials, or men on Township work, seconded by Charles Wehly. The motion passed.

Charles Wehly made a motion to adjourn at 8:45 P.M. seconded by Paul Rehoff.
