The Board of Supervisors of Codorus Township met at special session on April 8, 1976 at 7:30 P.M. Board members present were Charles Wehly, Paul Dehoff, and Leroy Thoman; the secretary, Goldie Day. Others present were Fred Wentz of Parkton Real Estate, Richard Brenneman, ~~Madison Stambaugh~~.

The Chairman, Charles Wehly, called the meeting to order.

Fred Wentz presented a sketch plan of the Whiteman farm (former Lewis Portner farm) showing 15 acres that Mr. Whiteman would like to sell to Mr. & Mrs. Aiken for agricultural purposes & still retain his building lot quota. Mr. Aiken would like to add as much farm land back to the original place as possible since he owns the buildings and 10 or so acres. The Board stated they could see no reason why this plan would not be acceptable, but advised Mr. Wentz to present the sketch to the next Township Planning Commission meeting for comments before going ahead with a plan.

Richard Brenneman asked if his son could place a mobile home on his property. There will be no subdivision since there will be no transfer of title to his son. Leroy Thoman made a motion for Mr. Brenneman to proceed with his plans, seconded by Paul Dehoff. The motion passed.

Leroy Thoman made a motion to go along with Manheim Township in a work exchange as in prior years. Paul Dehoff seconded this motion. The motion passed.

Paul Dehoff made a motion to award the bid on the Codorus Township property in Brodbeck (the former Bumpell & Leslie Wildasin property) to the high bidder, Mr. & Mrs. John Hicks of Parkton, Maryland.

who bid \$6,000.00 and to advise atty. Anstine to proceed with writing the deed. This motion seconded by Charles Wehly. The motion passed.

An ordinance for the enforcement of the Sewage Enforcement Officer was discussed but delayed for lack of sample ordinance to study.

Charles Wehly made a motion for the secretary to invest monies on hand in the best way she sees fit, seconded by Leroy Thoman.

The bills were presented to the Board. Paul Rehoff made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Leroy Thoman.

The minutes were read and approved.

Leroy Thoman made a motion to adjourn at 10:15 PM seconded by Paul Rehoff.
