

The Adams Township Board of Supervisors held a regularly scheduled meeting at 7:30 P.M. October 6, 1976 in the Township Bldg. Present were: Paul Rehoff, Charles Wehly, Leroy Thoman, members of the Board and the solicitor, W. Gary Austin and Secretary, Goldie Day. Others present were: Earl Erb, Daniel Shine, Fred Gentry, Mr. Nelson and Wm. Saughman, Paul Pisula, Mrs. Dean Winimiller, Mr. & Mrs. Louis Winkler and Mahlon Stambaugh.

The meeting was called to order by the Chairman, Charles Wehly.

Charles Wehly made a motion to approve the design and adopt resolution #10-7-1 for the Daniel Shine sub-division plan for submission to the Dept. of Environmental Resources, seconded by Paul Rehoff. Leroy Thoman objected to this motion. The motion passed by majority vote.

Leroy Thoman made a motion to adopt resolution #10-7-2 for submitting the Majorie Lampe plan to the Dept. of Environmental Resources, seconded by Paul Rehoff. The motion passed.

Paul Rehoff made a motion to adopt resolution #10-7-3 for submitting the Montgomery Brothers plan to the Dept. of Environmental Resources, seconded by Charles Wehly. The motion passed.

Mr. Earl Erb asked if he could subdivide a 12 acre wooded tract from his farm on Strickhouse Road. Leroy Thoman made a motion that Mr. Earl Erb be allowed to proceed with having a preliminary plan drawn up for this subdivision, seconded by Paul Rehoff. The motion passed.

Paul Pisula presented a plan of the Robert Paterno Snyder Mill Road Subdivision and asked the Board to sign the plan subject to the Dept. of Environmental Resources. Mr. Pisula was told that the Board would not

sign the plan until approval has been received from D. E. R. Resolution #9-2-76 was adopted at the September 2 meeting for this plan, but the completed module and percolation test results were not delivered to the secretary. The plan will be sent to DEC this month.

Mrs. Dean Kinemiller presented the final plan of their property along Narrow Gauge Road. This plan had been signed by the Township Planning Commission June 24, 1976. Leroy Thoman made a motion to approve the plan, seconded by Paul Dehoff. The motion passed and the plan was signed.

Mr. & Mrs. Louis Stinkler presented a preliminary plan of their 32 acre farm along Rt 216. Leroy Thoman made a motion to adopt Resolution #10-7-4 for submission to the Dept. of Environmental Resources, seconded by Paul Dehoff. The motion passed.

The bills were presented to the Board. Leroy Thoman made a motion to pay the bills seconded by Paul Dehoff. This motion passed.

Paul Dehoff made a motion to divide the Foreign Fire Insurance of \$928.60 equally between the Glen Rock and Jefferson Fire Companies, seconded by Leroy Thoman. This motion passed.

Paul Dehoff made a motion to accept the contract of Brocker Mfg. & Supply Co. in the amount of \$1590.00 for 2 Bridge Decks, seconded by Charles Wehly. The motion passed.

Leroy Thoman made a motion to issue two permits to General Telephone Co. seconded by Charles Wehly. This motion passed.

Board asked the solicitor to send a letter to the Russell, since in reference to the ad for the sale of his property, which is advertised in violation of the zoning ordinance with a copy of letter to the auctioneer. 269

Leroy Thoman made a motion to allow Russell time to refund 88¢ to Paul Sheppard for real estate tax overpaid, seconded by Paul Dehoff. This motion passed.

Leroy Thoman made a motion to request line painting on the roads again, seconded by Charles Wehly. Paul Dehoff opposed this motion. This pavement marking program is financed by the Federal Government and is done by State workers. There is no cost to the Township.

Paul Dehoff made a motion to hold a special meeting November 8, 1976 at 7:30 P.M. for opening bids and working on the budget, seconded by Charles Wehly. The motion passed. The secretary will advertise the special meeting.

Paul Dehoff made a motion to have the bid opening for the Caterpillar on November 8, 1976, seconded by Leroy Thoman.

Leroy Thoman made a motion to purchase a Cinder spreader, seconded by Paul Dehoff. The motion passed. The bids will be opened November 8 at 7:30 p.m.

Charles Wehly made a motion to accept the contract offered by the State for the plowing and Cindering of Rt. 516 from Sticks to Jefferson and the Shaffers Church Road for this winter at a cost of \$400.00 per mile of Road, provided the Township can use materials like is used on Township Roads, seconded by Paul Dehoff. The motion passed. The State contract would run from November 1, 1976 to April 15, 1977.

The minutes were read and approved by motion of Leroy Thoman, seconded by Paul Dehoff.

Paul Dehoff made a motion to adjourn at 11:45 PM seconded by Leroy Thoman.
