The minutes of the previous board meeting were read and approved. The minutes of the previous Supervisors meeting were read by members on an individual basis.

Frank Chester was present with the Robert Johnson Sr. plan. The board agreed that the plans should contain a note stating ~~that~~ that only trees be removed for the sewage area, house and driveway area.

Most of the rest should remain for erosion control. The motion was ~~made~~ made to pass the plan by Tom Moore and Seconded by Richard Masimone. The motion was passed and the plan was signed.

Kenneth Wright and Donald Worley were present with the Wright plan. There was discussion of the amount of square ft in the subdivision. It was supposed to be one acre 43,000 sq ft.

The plan will be changed and returned to a later meeting.

Mr & Mrs Albert Klispie were present concerning the Swartz 6 acre wood lot.

An on site inspection was made by Leray Thorman, Tom Moore, Richard Massmore, Charles Wheeler and Donald Bellinger.

The entire property involved is 83 acres.

The board decided not to allow a subdivision of the 6 acre lot.

Mr Richard Groff who own property along ~~the~~ Route 6/6 the former Wilson Miller property was present. He would like to sell approx $1\frac{2}{3}$ acres on the East side of Route 6/6. There is a possibility of not building on the lot. It could be sold as an unbuildable lot if it is so stated on the plan. However a plan must be drawn up and be passed.

Urim Rapphalt read his report.

He had the Leigh plan along. Mr Leigh wants to sell ~~of~~ The former Yenser building with 3 acres. The rest of the acreage will be merged with the Leigh farm.

There was a site inspection of the Patrick Fisher property. One lot would be at a sharp curve on the road and another possibility on the corner of the Chittum driveway. He is entitled to one, one acre lot. An adjoining farmer could buy the remainder of the property.

There was discussion on the township Garbage collection.

There was discussion on ordinance changes dealing with private roads.

There was a motion to approve the ordinance as corrected at the last meeting so it can be typed up and forwarded to the supervisors. Donald Ballinger made the motion with a second by Tom Moore, motion passed.

The meeting was adjourned on a motion by Leray Thorman and second by Richard Massimo.
