The Codorus Township Planning Commission met at 7:30 P.M. with Chairman Gordon Snyder presiding. Members Gordon Snyder, George Smith, Edward Newcomer and Earl Thoman were present. Joseph Hohenader represented York County Planning and Joseph Musso Sacra Engineer. Rev. Ralph Wright final plan was approved for lots #1 and #2 only after the motion of George Smith and the second of Earl Thoman. The Elwood Deveney final subdivision plan was returned for corrections to bring them in compliance with Sacra recommendations #1, 3, 4, 5, 7, 8 and 9.

Arthur Hupnagel submitted a sketch plan to secure preliminary information. The Codorus Twp. Planning Commission went on record to recommend that no more building permits be issued for The Hickory Ridge Development ~~being~~ until
