The Codorus Township Planning Commission met at 7:30 p.m. at a special meeting to discuss various means of preserving agricultural lands in the Township. Members Gordon Snyder, Dale Kempfing, Earl Thorman and Edward Newcomer were present. Attorney Malone attended.

Attorney Malone gave us the practical aspects of S.A. lot limitations in agricultural areas versus density control.

The Planning Commission consensus of opinion is that density control will probably preserve more agricultural land than the proposed S.A. limits.

Attorney Malone ^{agreed} to develop proposed changes to our zoning code, which would regulate in the area of density control, for our consideration.
