

August 8, 1990

The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met in regular session on August 8, 1990 at 7:30 P.M. in the Township office. Board members present were: Charles Wehrly and Lamar Glatfelter. Others present were: Larry Lucabaugh, Mr. & Mrs. Richard Townsend, Ruth Baer and Irvin Rappoldt.

Chairman Glatfelter opened the meeting with the Pledge to the Flag.

The minutes were approved as read.

The July treasurer's report was presented to the Board.

Ruth Baer gave the report of taxes collected during the month of July.

Richard & Julia Townsend presented the revised plan of their property along Miller Road. The revised plan is for two lots instead of four as previously proposed.

Charles Wehrly made a motion to approve the revised subdivision plan of Richard & Julia Townsend, seconded by Lamar Glatfelter. This motion passed and the plan was signed.

The Board agreed to give the Townsends credit for two of the septic inspections of the four lots previously perked. This will be \$100.00 credited to their bill for costs to the Township.

C.S. Davidson has asked for the Boards approval and signature of the Chairman to bill York County for payment of engineering fees connected with the Sewerage Study and Stream Improvements in the Glenville area. The Sewerage study has been completed. The Stream Improvement project has not been completed.

Lamar Glatfelter made a motion to approve the request of C.S. Davidson for two Block Grant payments to the firm by York County. Charles Wehrly seconded this motion. This motion passed.

Irvin Rappoldt gave the report of building permits issued during the month of July.

Mr. Rappoldt reported that Steven Gantz would like to meet with the Board members regarding bringing a driveway from his place of business to Nafe Sawmill Road. He seems to be unable to get a Commercial Driveway Permit from the State and proposes to have the entrance from the Nafe Sawmill Road. The Board will set up a time with Mr. Gantz for this meeting.

Mr. Rappoldt is still working on the swimming pool violations and will have a report at a later date. He also wants to look into the Junk Yard violations.

The secretary reported that Lawrence Vance had called. He wanted to know if the Alternate Sewage Enforcement Officer, John Klinedinst, would accept the report of a soil scientist on his lot along Shaffer's Church Road.

The Secretary had talked with John Klinedinst regarding this and was told by Mr. Klinedinst that he would not issue a septic permit from a report by a soil scientist. The report would only be for the probe hole. Mr. Klinedinst said he would need to examine the percolation test holes. This information will be send to Mr. Vance.

The bills were presented to the Board.

Charles Wehrly made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Lamar Glatfelter. This motion passed.

The meeting adjourned at 9:30 P.M. on motion by Lamar Glatfelter and second by Charles Wehrly.
