

March 1, 1990

The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met in regular session on March 1, 1990 at 7:30 P.M. in the township office. Board members present were: Lamar Glatfelter, Leroy Thoman and Charles Wehrly. Others present were Joann Snyder, Randy Sterner and Zack Thoman, Tom Baum and Pat Seitz and Scott Barnett.

Chairman Glatfelter called the meeting to order by the pledge to the Flag.

The minutes were approved as individually read.

Jaonn Snyder gave the report of delinquent taxes collected during the month of February, and asked the Board to send refunds to two taxpayers for 1989 taxes paid.

Charles Wehrly made a motion to refund \$15.89 to Francis & Helen Fischer and \$37.65 to William & Genevieve Gilbert, seconded by Leroy Thoman. This motion passed. These refunds are for 1989 real estates taxes previously paid.

The bills were presented to the Board. Lamar Glatfelter made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Leroy Thoman. This motion passed.

Randy Sterner, the Township Emergency Management Coordinator, was present with Tom Baum, Zack Thoman and Pat Seitz from the Jefferson Fire Company and Scott Barnett from the York County Emergency Management Center.

Mr. Barnett spoke on radiological problems during an emergency and explained the training available for radiological monitoring. He teaches classes for this and would be willing to come to this area if a class of twelve to fifteen could be arranged. Also, classes are taught at the Emigsville Fire School. The representatives from Jefferson Fire Company will try to get enough interested persons to have the training classes in this area sometime over the summer.

Zack Thoman stated that he feels Codorus Township should work with the Fire Companies in the operation of the Emergency Operations Plan.

Mr. Barnett stated that the State does all the aerial monitoring and that the radiological monitoring classes would count towards the Hazard Materials course.

The Board asked that the Zoning Officer, Irvin Rappoldt, check out the following two properties for zoning violations. It is believed and has been reported that Glenn Smith is operating an auto repair shop at his residence along Rt. 216, across from Sunny Slope Road. Also, Dalone Swartz may be operating some type of business in the new building he has on his property along Shaffer's Church Road.

The Board discussed some changes to the Zoning Ordinance:

- (1) Change Section 703-1 (1) to read 9 square feet
- (2) Change Section 703-2 (1) to read 9 square feet
- (3) Section 904 - delete number 6

The meeting adjourned 10:30 P.M. on motion by Charles Wehrly and second by Leroy Thoman.
