

August 2, 1990

The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met in regular session on August 2, 1990 at 7:30 P.M. in the Township office. Board members present were: Lamar Glatfelter, Leroy Thoman and Charles Wehrly. Others present were: Larry Lucabaugh.

Chairman Glatfelter opened the meeting with the pledge to the flag.

The minutes were approved as written.

The secretary reported that William Vance wanted to know if the Board would give him a septic permit for his lot along Shaffer's Church Road if he gets a soil scientist to say that the soil is suitable for the installation of a system. The Board will seek the opinion of the alternate Sewage Enforcement Officer, John Klinedinst, before making a decision on this.

Mrs. Timothy Doll had inquired about a "CHILDREN AT PLAY" sign for the private road that serves their property. She also wanted to know if the Township would spray for mosquitos in the area across from their property.

Since the Dolls live along a private road, the Township will not furnish the sign. She will have to purchase or make a sign. Also, the Board will not spray for mosquitos.

The bills were presented to the Board. Leroy Thoman made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Charles Wehrly. This motion passed.

Larry Lucabaugh had questions regarding the proposed amendment to the Zoning Ordinance regarding the transfer of building rights. He feels strongly that the transfer of non-contiguous lots in the same ownership should be allowed. Larry was told that the proposed amendment regarding the transfer of lots will not be enacted before a meeting in November.

The meeting adjourned at 9:30 P.M. on motion by Charles Wehrly and second by Leroy Thoman.
