

November 1, 1990

The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met in regular session on November 1, 1990 at 7:30 P.M. in the township office. Board members present were Lamar Glatfelter and Leroy Thoman. Others present were: Leo Houser, Larry Lucabaugh, Mr. & Mr. Joe Delozier and Randy Sterner.

Chairman Glatfelter opened the meeting with the pledge to the Flag.

The minutes were approved as written.

The 3-lot subdivision plan of Joseph Delozier was submitted by Mr. Delozier and Larry Lucabaugh. Leroy Thoman made a motion to approve the plan, seconded by Lamar Glatfelter. This motion passed and the plan was signed.

Larry Lucabaugh asked to speak regarding the proposed amendments to the Township Zoning ordinance which have been advertised for discussion at a public hearing November 14, 1990 at 7:30 P.M. Chairman Glatfelter told Mr. Lucabaugh that he will have a chance to comment at the public hearing.

Mr. Leo Houser stated he is having a problem with the water run-off at the new construction site at Friendship Elementary School. There are two retention ponds, one in the back and one in the front of the proposed building. Water run-off through his property washes out and down onto Robert Fisher's property. Mr. Houser wants the record to state that he is not pleased with the problem and wants to know what can be done to correct the run-off.

Lee Irwin, Erosion Control Coordinator has checked this problem at Friendship School and has a letter in the mail to the Board. When this letter is received, a copy will be sent to Mr. Houser. The Board will have the Township engineer inspect the site if the violations are not corrected.

Mr. Houser was asked to attend the meeting on November 14 for further discussion on this matter.

Lamar Glatfelter made a motion to appoint George Willims to another three-year term on the Township Zoning Hearing Board. The new term will run from January 1, 1991 to December 31, 1993. Leroy Thoman seconded this motion. This motion passed.

Randy Sterner reported that there has not been any activity on the Emergency Management Plan.

The bills were presented to the Board. Leroy Thoman made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Lamar Glatfelter. This motion passed.

The 1991 proposed budget was reviewed and will be ready for advertising after the November 14th meeting with a December 12th tentative date for approval.

The meeting adjourned at 10:30 P.M. on motion of Lamar Glatfelter and second by Leroy Thoman.
