

December 6, 1990

The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met in regular session on December 6, 1990 at 7:30 P.M. in the township office. Board members present were: Lamar Glatfelter, Charles Wehrly and Leroy Thoman. Others present were: Irvin Rappoldt, James Bailey and Mr. & Mrs. Darrell Henry.

Chairman Glatfelter opened the meeting with the Pledge to the Flag.

The minutes were approved as written. The treasurer's report was presented to the Board.

The secretary read the tax collector's report for the month of November.

Charles Wehrly made a motion to refund a 1990 real estate tax refund in the amount of \$2.54 to Paul Dehoff as requested by the tax collector. Lamar Glatfelter seconded this motion. The motion passed.

Leroy Thoman made a motion to authorize the Chairman to sign the Road Occupancy permit for the proposed work on Sunny Slope Road. Charles Wehrly seconded this motion. This motion passed.

Irvin Rappoldt gave the report of building permits issued during the month of November. Mr. Rappoldt had issued a permit to Darrell Henry for a 41 x 411 ft. hog barn. The Board had some questions regarding this permit since Mr. Henry has 30 plus acres and has adjoining properties within 500 feet of this property. Zoning Officer Rappoldt called Gilbert Malone, Solicitor to the Planning Commission for his opinion on this. Solicitor Malone called Mr. Rappoldt after the meeting and told him that the hog barn met Zoning requirements and the Henrys could proceed with their plans.

The bills were presented to the Board. Lamar Glatfelter made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Charles Wehrly. This motion passed.

Since the Board will meet for the organizational meeting on January 7th, it was decided to cancel the regular meeting scheduled for January 9th. Solicitor Herrold will be notified of this change. He may want to attend the regular sheduled meeting for January 3rd.

The meeting adjourned at 10:00 P.M. on motion of Leroy Thoman and second. by Charles Wehrly.
