

August 1, 1991

The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met in regular session on August 1, 1991 at 7:30 P.M. in the Township office. Board members present were Lamar Glatfelter and Leroy Thoman. Others present were Irvin Rappoldt, Rick Sechrist and Scarlett Alban.

Chairman Glatfelter called the meeting to order with the pledge to the Flag.

The minutes were approved as written.

Irvin Rappoldt wanted to check the flood map for the property Charles Grove owns along Rt. 216. The property does not show as being in the flood area.

Mr. Rappoldt stated he will not check the building at the Michael & Trudy Jones property unless a Supervisor is with him. Chairman Glatfelter told him to contact Supervisor Wehrly to set up a time for him to go with him to the Jones property.

Mr. Rappoldt will also check the driveway at the Van'Scoyoc property along Greenmount Church Road and will check with Paul Sharp regarding the proposed living quarters for his sister, Carol Altland.

Scarlett Alban presented the 2-lot subdivision plan of a ten acre tract along Smith Road. Leroy Thoman made a motion to approve the Alban plan, seconded by Lamar Glatfelter. This motion passed and the plan was signed.

Chairman Glatfelter reported that he had talked to Perry Kroh regarding the siren (Big Red). The Borough of Glen Rock proposes to relocate this siren in the vicinity of the Glen Rock Sewer plant. The Board made no decision on helping with the cost of relocating this siren.

A burning ordinance was discussed, but the Board feels that with the State and County having ordinances to regulate burning and water conservation, it would not be necessary for the Township to adopt such ordinances at this time.

Lamar Glatfelter made a motion to adopt the Resolution required by Berkheimer Associates. This resolution states that the Township secretary is designated as the person to receive information from Berkheimer Associates regarding delinquent per capita taxes. Leroy Thoman seconded this motion. The motion passed.

The bills were presented to the Board. Leroy Thoman made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Lamar Glatfelter. This motion passed.

The meeting adjourned at 9:00 P.M. on motion by Lamar Glatfelter and second by Leroy Thoman.
