

December 5, 1991

The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met in regular session on December 5, 1991 at 7:30 P.M. in the Township office. Board members present were: Lamar Glatfelter, Leroy Thoman and Charles Wehrly. Others present were: Irvin Rappoldt, Rick Sechrist, James Bailey and Robert Perry.

Chairman Glatfelter opened the meeting with the Pledge.

The minutes were approved as written. The treasurer's report was presented to the board members.

Leroy Thoman made a motion to appoint Leland Snyder to another three-year term to the Zoning Hearing Board. Mr. Snyder's term will run from January 1, 1992 to December 31, 1994. Charles Wehrly seconded this motion. This motion passed.

Charles Wehrly made a motion to issue a road occupancy permit to General Telephone, seconded by Lamar Glatfelter. This motion passed.

The bills were reviewed by the Board members. Charles Wehrly made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Lamar Glatfelter. This motion passed.

Irvin Rappoldt gave the report of building permits issued during the month of November.

Mr. Rappoldt reported that he had stopped in to talk to William Wilson, Jr. and told him that something has to be done regarding the junk yard he has created at his property along Messersmith Road. The Board instructed Mr. Rappoldt to send Mr. Wilson a letter, giving him a time to clean up or face prosecution.

The Board discussed January, 1992 meeting dates. The Organization meeting will be held January 6, 1992. The Board decided to meet the first Thursday, January 2, unless the Solicitor has objections to cancelling the meeting for the second Wednesday. This will be decided at the December 11 meeting.

Rick Sechrist had some questions of the Board regarding the Philip Wagner subdivision plan. Mr. Sechrist has contacted Mr. Wagner regarding work on the street/cul-de-sac. He also wants to find out from the solicitors if he would be creating a conflict of interest by performing work on this project. He did not approach Mr. Wagner regarding this work until after the plan had been approved by the Township. If his doing work in the Township causes any problems, he stated he will have to resign as a member of the Planning Commission.

The meeting adjourned at 9:00 P.M. on motion by Leroy Thoman and second by Lamar Glatfelter.
