

March 7, 1991

The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met in regular session on March 7, 1991 at 7:30 P.M. in the township office. Board members present were: Lamar Glatfelter, Leroy Thoman and Charles Wehrly. Others present were: Mr. & Mrs. Melvin Bricker and Nelson Brenneman.

Chairman Glatfelter called the meeting to order after the pledge to the flag.

The minutes were approved as written except to change Mrs. Perry's home occupation from Hill Climb Road to Chestnut Grove Road. Correction made.

The treasurer's report was given to the board for the month of February.

Mr. & Mrs. Melvin Bricker presented the final 2-lot plan of their property along Shaffer's Church Road. The agreement for the transfer of lots had been signed by Mr. & Mrs. Bricker and the Vice-president of Peoples Bank. Also, the planning module has been approved by the Pa. Dept. of Environmental Resources.

Leroy Thoman made a motion to approve the Melvin & Mildred Bricker subdivision plan and to approve the agreement, seconded by Charles Wehrly. This motion passed and the plan was signed. The chairman signed the agreement. Mr. & Mrs. Bricker will take the agreement to the court house for recording.

The secretary had the report of taxes collected by Ruth Baer for the month of February. Mrs. Baer asked for exoneration of 10 1990 per capita taxes. These ten have moved from the township.

Lamar Glatfelter made a motion to exonerate the tax collector for ten 1990 per capita taxes, seconded by Charles Wehrly. This motion passed.

Nelson Brenneman asked about requirements on set back lines if he rebuilds his barn along Heindel Road. The barn was recently destroyed by fire. The Board told Mr. Brenneman that he would not have to meet existing set backs only if he builds on the existing foundation. He is not to build any closer to the road, but should stay back from Heindel Road as much as possible. If he decides not to use the original foundation, then he would have to abide by present set back requirements. He was also told that he would need a building permit if he re-builds the barn.

The bills were presented to the Board. Leroy Thoman made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Charles Wehrly. This motion passed.

The Board discussed new road construction for 1991 and will solicit bids for resurfacing Shaffer's Church Road from Rt. 616 to Cherry Run Road. Rohrbaugh Road will be finished, using general fund monies. State Liquid Fuels Tax monies will be used for Shaffer's Church Road.

The meeting adjourned at 10:00 P.M. on motion of Charles Wehrly and second by Leroy Thoman.
