

April 4, 1991

The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met in regular session on April 4, 1991 at 7:30 P.M. in the township office. Board members present were: Lamar Glatfelter, Charles Wehrly and Leroy Thoman. Others present were: James Failey, Rick Sechrist, Harry Brose of Roadite and Glenn Wilt of York Building Supply and Mahlon Martin.

Chairman Glatfelter opened the meeting with the pledge to the Flag.

The minutes were approved as written.

Sealed bids were opened as advertised for road materials.

Two bids for stone aggregates were received:

(1) York Building Products bid as follows:

(2) Wimpey Minerals (Hanover Lime & Stone Co. ) bid as follows:

Both bidders provided a bid bond and had signed the Non-Collusion Affidavit.

Charles Wehrly made a motion to award the bid to Wimpey Minerals, the low bidder, seconded by Leroy Thoman. The motion passed by unanimous vote.

Two bids were received for E-3 Emulsion

- (1) Wm. S. Hammaker bid 70,000 gals. @ \$0.572 per gallon - Total \$40,040.  
(2) Roadite bid 70,000 gals. @ \$0.568 per gallon - Total \$39,760.

Lamar Glatfelter made a motion to award the E-3 Emulsion bid to Roadite, the low bidder, seconded by ~~Lamar Glatfelter~~ **LEROY THOMAN**. This motion passed by unanimous vote.

Two bids were received for furnishing 6,000 Tons of ID-2 binder delivered to job site:

- (1) York Building Products bid 6,000 Tons of ID-2 binder @ \$22.00 per Ton for a total bid price of \$132,000.00  
(2) Bituminous Paving Materials of York, Inc. bid 6,000 Tons of ID-2 Binder @ \$21.95 per Ton for a total bid price of \$131,700.

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Leroy Thoman made a motion to postpone the award of this bid to April 10, 1991. Lamar Glatfelter seconded this motion. The motion passed by unanimous vote.

Two bids were received for Placing 6,000 Tons of ID-2 Binder:

- (1) Roadite bid \$4.25 per ton for placing 6,000 Tons of ID-2 Binder for a total of \$25,500.00
- (2) Emory J. Peters Excavating & Paving Contractor bid \$5.20 per ton for placing 6,000 Tons of ID-2 Binder, for a total of \$31,200.00.

Leroy Thoman made a motion to award the bid for placing 6,000 Tons of ID-2 Binder to Roadite, seconded by Lamar Glatfelter. This motion passed by unanimous vote.

One bid was received for furnishing and placing 490 tons of Latex Modified Emulsion pavement Type A. Roadite bid \$110.00 per ton for placing 490 Tons of Latex Modified Emulsion Pavement, Type A, for a total bid price of \$53,900.

Leroy Thoman made a motion to award the bid for furnishing and placing 490 Tons of Latex Modified Emulsion Pavement, Type A to Roadite, the sole bidder. Charles Wehrly seconded this motion. The motion passed by unanimous vote.

Mahlon Martin was present regarding building a 40 x 500 ft. chicken house on his property. He was told that this is a permitted use in the agricultural district. Mr. Martin stated he can use all the manure (dry) on his farm land.

The secretary gave the tax collector's report for the month of March. The tax collector asked to be exonerated for 2 1990 per capita taxes.

Lamar Glatfelter made a motion to exonerate Ruth Baer the Tax Collector for two 1990 per capita taxes, seconded by Charles Wehrly. This motion passed.

Leroy Thoman made a motion to have the green International Dump Truck overhauled by Sheets Truck Center at an estimated cost of \$3,000-\$4,000., seconded by Lamar Glatfelter. This motion passed.

The bills were presented to the Board. Leroy Thoman made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Charles Wehrly. This motion passed.

The meeting adjourned at 9:45 P.M. on motion by Lamar Glatfelter and second by Leroy Thoman.
