The meeting opened by the Pledge to the Flag.

The minutes were approved as written.

The treasurer's report was presented to the Board.

Larry Lucabaugh presented the final subdivision plan for the Gene and Anna May Burton property. Charles Wehrly made a motion to approve the Burton plan, seconded by Lamar Glatfelter. This motion passed and the plan was signed.

The Board told Charles Wehrly to contact someone about line painting for the portion of Shaffer's Church Road that was resurfaced this summer.

The Board decided to order salt for the winter from Cargill at a price of \$37.61 per ton delivered.

The Board reviewed the preliminary plan of Philip Wagner. The engineer has requested that the Soil Conservation office review the plan. Larry Lucabaugh stated the Mr. Wagner is getting a copy of the plan to the SCS and copies of the plan to the utility companies.

The bills were presented to the board. Leroy Thoman made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Charles Wehrly. This motion passed.

The meeting adjourned at 9:30 P.M. on motion by Charles Wehrly and second by Leroy Thoman.
