

November 7, 1991

The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met in regular session on November 7, 1991 at 7:30 P.M. in the Township office. Board members present were: Lamar Glatfelter, Charles Wehrly and Leroy Thoman. Other present were Harry & Esther Sterner, Calvin Amspacher, Larry Lucabaugh, Julia Townsend, Susan Dell and Rick Sechrist.

Chairman Glatfelter opened the meeting with the Pledge.

The minutes were approved as written. The treasurer's report was presented to the Board members.

Harry Sterner and Calvin Amspacher presented their subdivision plan which squares up their property lines only.

Leroy Thoman made a motion to approve the Harry & Esther Sterner & Calvin & Lora Amspacher subdivision plan, seconded by Charles Wehrly. This motion passed and the plan was signed.

Larry Lucabaugh stated he wanted to talk to the Board members relative to three plans coming up. He feels these plans are against the Zoning Ordinance. The three plans he referred to were: The James Holley plan, the James Miller plan and the Arthur Wachter plan. He stated that these plans all have larger lots than allowed by the Ordinance. Larry asked if anything in the Ordinance had changed that would allow these larger lots.

The Board made no decision on Larry's request that these plan be turned down, since the final plans have not been presented to the Board of Supervisors for approval.

Susan Dell, a resident living along Rt. 516, had questions regarding recycling. She feels that there should be some drop-off point for residents that wish to recycle certain items. She was told that the Township had discussed this at length with a representative from York Waste Disposal and decided against any action due to the cost involved. She was also told that there are places in the county that persons may take their recycables.

Charles Wehrly made a motion to authorize the Chairman to sign the Emergency Operations Plan Resolution, seconded by Lamar Glatfelter. This motion passed.

Leroy Thoman made a motion to approve the Emergency Operations Plan Promulgation, seconded by Charles Wehrly. This motion passed and the Promulgation was signed by all three Board members.

Leroy Thoman made a motion to authorize the Chairman to sign the Indemnity Agreement requested by the York Area Earned Income Tax Bureau, seconded by Charles Wehrly. This motion passed and the Agreement was signed by Chairman Glatfelter.

The bills were presented to the Board. Charles Wehrly made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Lamar Glatfelter. This motion passed.
