

July 2, 1992

The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met in regular session on July 2, 1992 at 7:30 P.M. in the township office. Board members present were: Lamar Glatfelter, James Bailey and Charles Wehrly. Others present were Rick Sechrist and Irvin Rappoldt.

Chairman Glatfelter opened the meeting with the pledge.

The minutes were approved as written. The treasurer's report was presented to the Board members.

Irvin Rappoldt gave the report of building permits issued during the month of June. Mr. Rappoldt reported that he had been contacted by the new buyer of the former Martin Hamberger property along Fairs School Road. The buyers will use the property as a weekend retreat only and will be storing antiques at the property. They would like to convert the garage to living quarters for a caretaker. The Board will talk to Solicitor Herrold to find out if this would be allowed in an agricultural zone.

James Bailey made a motion to issue a road occupancy permit to GTE, seconded by Charles Wehrly. The motion passed. This permit is for Sunny Slope Road.

The Board reviewed the automobile insurance deductibles and cost figures and decided to keep the deductibles now in force until the renewal date. Upon renewal, the deductibles will be reviewed for any changes necessary.

The resurfacing of Shaffers Church Road took less material than was bid. The Board decided to use the balance of the materials and work bid to resurface Shaffer Road as far as it will reach. This work will need to be approved by the State.

The bills were presented to the Board.

Lamar Glatfelter made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Charles Wehrly. This motion passed.

The meeting adjourned at 9:30 P.M. on motion by James Bailey and seconded by Lamar Glatfelter.
