

September 3, 1992

The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met in regular session on September 3, 1992 at 7:30 P.M. in the Township office. Board members present were: Lamar Glatfelter, James Bailey and Charles Wehrly. Others present were: Rick Sechrist.

Chairman Glatfelter opened the meeting with the Pledge.

The minutes were approved as written.

The treasurer's report was presented to the Board members.

The tax collector was not present, but asked the secretary to present the August tax collection report. She also asked that 1992 real estate tax refunds be made to Tony & Christine Dubs and to the Jefferson Sportsmans' Club.

Charles Wehrly made a motion to refund \$2.48 to Tony & Christine Dubs and \$11.31 to the Jefferson Sportsmans' Club, seconded by James Bailey. This motion passed.

The Board members reviewed the proposed amendment to the Township Zoning Ordinance that Solicitor Herrold had prepared. This amendment would allow the storage of explosives in the Agricultural District as a permitted use. This proposed amendment meets with the Boards approval and should be ready for advertisement for adoption and review by the York County Planning Commission.

The secretary was advised to advertise for bids for a new 1993 Pickup Truck. The bids are to be opened on October 14th at 7:30 P.M. The 1978 Ford Pickup will be traded-in on the new truck.

The Board read a letter from the Tri-Community Ambulance Relief Association, asking for an allocation of the monies the Township receives from the State Volunteer Fire Relief Fund. These monies have been paid to the Relief Funds of the four fire companies serving the Township.

Lamar Glatfelter made a motion to include the Tri-Community Ambulance Relief Association in the distribution of the funds received from the State and to allocate the monies as follows:

Glen Rock Firemens Relief Association	35	per	cent
Jefferson Firemens Relief Association	30	"	"
Seven Valleys Firemens Relief Association	10	"	"
New Freedom Firemens Relief Association	15	"	"
Tri-Community Ambulance Relief Association	10	"	"

James Bailey seconded this motion. This motion passed.

Charles Wehrly made a motion for the Chairman to sign the Cash Management and Master Purchase Agreement with the Farmers Bank, seconded by James Bailey. This motion passed.

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James Bailey made a motion to bill Manheim Township for work performed by Codorus Township employees as follows:

(1) employee only - regular rate of pay


(2) employee & truck - \$25.00 per hour
