

November 5, 1992

The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met in regular session on November 5, 1992 at 7:30 P.M. Board members present were: Lamar Glatfelter, James Bailey and Charles Wehrly. Others present were: Rick Sechrist, Mary L. Marzullo and Irvin Rappoldt.

Chairman Glatfelter opened the meeting with the Pledge.

The minutes were approved as written.

Mary L. Marzullo presented the two-lot final plan of their property. All local, State & County requirements have been met. Charles Wehrly made a motion to approve the Richard & Mary L. Marzullo subdivision plan, seconded by James Bailey. This motion passed.

Lamar Glatfelter made a motion to award the pick-up truck bid to Marley Gross Ford, Spring Grove, PA. Charles Wehrly seconded this motion. The motion passed. This was the low bidder for a new 1993 4 x 4 diesel pick-up.

James Bailey made a motion to appoint Ann Corum to another three year term on the Codorus Township Zoning Hearing Board. Charles Wehrly seconded this motion. This motion passed. Mrs. Corum's new term will run from January 1, 1993 to December 31, 1995.

Charles Wehrly made a motion to retain the same tax structure for 1993:

- (1) \$5.00 per capita tax
- (2) 1/2 of one mill real estate tax (.0005)
- (3) 1/2 of 1% earned income tax
- (4) 1/2 of 1% real estate transfer tax

Lamar Glatfelter seconded this motion. This motion passed.

Irvin Rappoldt wishes to dedicate Glenville School Road as a Township Road. He has put the road in to Township specifications. The road description and map will be given to Solicitor Herrold for approval before adoption.

Lamar Glatfelter made a motion to approve the Wilbur Gallagher planning module for submission to D.E.R., seconded by James Bailey. This motion passed.

The bills were presented to the Board. James Bailey made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Lamar Glatfelter. This motion passed.

The Board reviewed the 1993 proposed budget and authorized the secretary to advertise the budget as being open for public inspection. The final budget will be adopted December 9, 1992.

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Irvin Rappoldt reported that he had been asked what permitted uses would be for the building in Bonnair that had been used for furniture refinishing by Sam Adams. The building burned, has been repaired and sold by Adams to Carl P. Andre and Preston Beall.

Mr. Rappoldt will check with the Township Planning Commission regarding this since the new owners wish to use the building (20x60) for commercial use.

The meeting adjourned at 10:30 P.M. on motion by Charles Wehrly and second by James Bailey.
