

December 3, 1992

The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Thursday, December 3, 1992 at 7:30 P.M. in the Township office. Board members present were: Lamar Glatfelter, James Bailey and Charles Wehrly. Others present were James Miller and Irvin Rappoldt.

Chairman Glatfelter opened the meeting with the pledge.

The minutes were approved as written.

The treasurer's report for November was presented to each Board member.

James Miller was present with the subdivision plan that was previously approved and signed on January 2, 1992. The plan has not been recorded due to someone in the Recorder of Deeds office negligence.

Since 90 days have passed since the plan was signed, James Bailey made a motion to re-approve the James & Doris Miller plan, seconded by Charles Wehrly. This motion passed.

The secretary reported that she had received a call from Joan Rossi who lives along Raleigh Court. Mrs. Rossi is concerned about a travel trailer that has been parked along the Cul-de-sac since July. Emergency equipment would not be able to get through. Supervisor Charles Wehrly will contact the owner of the travel trailer, Reid Taylor, and ask that he remove same from the Cul-de-sac. If the trailer is not moved after this, the Solicitor will be asked to send a letter to Mr. Taylor or the Board will ask the State Police to see that the trailer is removed from where it is now parked.

Cathy Shive did a project on the speed limit for Shaffer Road. This was a school requirement. Cathy researched the materials in the report and feels that there should be a speed limit for Shaffer Road. The Board will have a traffic study done by the York County Planning Commission and will post speed limit signs if recommended by the study.

Irvin Rappoldt gave the report of building permits issued during November.

Mr. Rappoldt was given a copy of the letter written to David Smith by the Solicitor, asking Mr. Smith to remove the junk from his property within twenty days. Mr. Rappoldt will check the property to see that the junk is being taken away.

The Board again considered the Glen Rock Volunteer Fire Company request for a donation to the Capital Fund Raising Campaign. Lamar Glatfelter made a motion to pledge \$1,500.00 to the fund with \$500.00 being given now and \$500.00 in 1993 and \$500.00 in 1994. Charles Wehrly seconded this motion. This motion passed.

The bills were presented to the Board. Charles Wehrly made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by James Bailey. This motion passed.

The meeting adjourned at 9:45 P.M. on motion by Lamar Glatfelter and second by Charles Wehrly.
