

March 4, 1993

The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met in regular session on March 4, 1993 at 7:30 P.M. in the Township office. Board members present were: James Bailey, Lamar Glatfelter and Charles Wehrly. Others present were: Irvin Rappoldt, Rick Sechrist, Mrs. Wilbur Gallagher, Ed Scheiner, Douglas Crawford, Earl Keiser, Jr. and Mr. & Mrs. Ronald Flemmens.

Chairman Glatfelter called the meeting to order with the Pledge.

The minutes were approved as written. The treasurer's report for February was presented to the Board members.

Ed Scheiner of O'Connor, Piper & Flynn presented the 4 lot subdivision plan of the Wilbur Gallagher property. James Bailey made a motion to approve the Gallagher plan, seconded by Charles Wehrly. This motion passed. The Gallaghers had a copy of an agreement they have with Ned & Brenda Myers. The lot lines between the Myers and Gallaghers will be changed to comply with the Supervisors concern regarding road frontage.

Douglas Crawford and Earl Keiser, Jr. presented the plan proposed by Claude and Anna Rohrbaugh. Charles Wehrly made a motion to approve the Planning Module for this plan for submission to the PA. D.E.R., seconded by James Bailey. This motion passed. Mr. Crawford will also prepare the Storm Water management plan for this property so that a copy may be sent to the Township engineer for review.

Mr. & Mrs. Ronald Flemmens had the 2-lot subdivision plan for the George Wisner Estate. The plan seems to comply with Township ordinances. James Bailey made a motion to approve FORM B, Request for non-buildable waiver for submission to D.E.R., seconded by Charles Wehrly. This motion passed.

Lamar Glatfelter made a motion to issue licenses to Springfield Contractors and Paige Reed for the storage of high explosives/fireworks for the Year 1993. James Bailey seconded this motion. Both parties have paid the \$100.00 annual license fee.

A letter from Buchart Horn, Inc. was read. This letter was to notify the Township that New Freedom Borough is applying to the PA. Department of Environmental Resources for a permit to dispose of wastewater treatment plant sludge by agricultural utilization on lands farmed by Paul Dehoff. These lands are on Fair School Road approximately one mile southeast of Glen Rock. No action was taken on this matter.

The bills were presented to the Board. Lamar Glatfelter made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Charles Wehrly. This motion passed.

The meeting adjourned at 9:45 P.M. on motion by James Bailey and second by Charles Wehrly.
