

December 2, 1993

The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Thursday, December 2, 1993 at 7:30 P.M. in the Township office. Board members present were: Lamar Glatfelter, Charles Wehrly and James Bailey. Others present were: Irvin Rappoldt, Ruth Baer and Tom Moore.

Chairman Glatfelter called the meeting to order with the Pledge.

The minutes were approved as written.

Irvin Rappoldt gave the Zoning Officer report for the month of November. He stated he had nothing new to report on the Lamar Wolfgang violation. A copy of a judgment filed against Mr. Wolfgang was received from District Magistrate Margaret Klinedinst. A judgment in the amount of \$559.72 was filed on September 22, 1993, Docket #CV-0000268-93.

The Board asked Irvin to check out a recreational vehicle on the property adjoining Alfred Elliott on Chadwick Court. Mr. Elliott believes that someone is living in the vehicle since water is running onto his property from the RV.

Irvin wants to subdivide the existing house from his acreage along Fissel Church Road and needs a Form B signed for submission to D.E.R.

James Bailey made a motion that the Secretary sign Form B for the Rappoldt subdivision, subject to the Township Planning Commission approving this Form at the December 9th meeting. Charles Wehrly seconded this motion. The motion carried.

Ruth Baer gave the report of taxes collected during the month of November. She asked to be exonerated for the collection of 163 per capita taxes for the Year 1993. These exonerations are for students, low income, persons that have moved from the Township, etc.

Charles Wehrly made a motion to exonerate Ruth Baer for the collection of 163 per capita taxes for the Year 1993, seconded by Lamar Glatfelter. This motion passed.

James Bailey made a motion to appoint the firm of S E O Services, Inc. with William A. Deal, owner, as Certified Sewage Enforcement Officer for the Year 1994, seconded by Lamar Glatfelter. This motion carried.

The bills were presented to the Board. Charles Wehrly made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by James Bailey. This motion carried.

The meeting adjourned at 10:00 P.M. on motion by Charles Wehrly and second by James Bailey.
