

April 1, 1993

The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met in regular session on April 1, 1993 at 7:30 P.M. in the Township office. Board members present were: Lamar Glatfelter, James Bailey and Charles Wehrly. Others present were: Irvin Rappoldt, Rick Sechrist, a representative from Wm. Hammaker, Inc., Glenn Wilt from York Building Products, Terry Shutz of PennRoc and Mr. & Mrs. Ronald Flemmens.

Chairman Glatfelter called the meeting to order with the Pledge.

The minutes were approved as written.

Bids for road materials were opened as advertised.

Three bids were received for 70,000 gallons of E-3 Emulsion:

- (1) Roadite, Inc. bid \$.6325 per gallon for a total price of \$44,275.00
- (2) Wm. Hammaker bid \$.669 per gallon for a total bid price of \$46,830.00
- (3) Wilson Paving bid \$.730 per gallon for a total bid price of \$51,100.00

Charles Wehrly made a motion to award the bid for E-3 Emulsion to the low bidder, Roadite, Inc. James Bailey seconded this motion. This motion passed.

After the bids on stone were read, Glenn Wilt of York Building Products stated that he understood that a bidder had to be listed in PENNDOT'S Bulletin #14 as an approved bidder. Tri-Boro Concrete, Inc. is not listed. Mr. Terry Shutz of PennRoc was present and replied that his Company is listed as an approved supplier in Bulletin 14, and that Tri-Boro would either get the stone from PennRoc or another approved supplier. Mr. Glenn Wilt had heard that by using a bidder not listed in Bulletin 14, a Township may lose State Liquid Fuels Tax monies. Charles Wehrly called Eugene Smeltzer, the PennDot District Municipal Services Supervisor for this District, to get his opinion. Mr. Smelter stated that the bid could be awarded to Tri-Boro Concrete, but to have a letter from Tri-Boro, stating that the stone would be supplied by an approved quarry.

Lamar Glatfelter made a motion that the stone bid be awarded to the low bidder, Tri-Boro Concrete, Inc., subject to a letter from Tri-Boro to the Township stating that the stone would be purchased from an approved supplier. This letter is to be received by the Township no later than September 14, 1993. James Bailey seconded this motion. This motion passed.

Two bids were received for furnishing 3,000 tons of ID wearing.

York Building Products bid \$21.95 per ton for a total of \$65,850.00.
Bituminous Paving Materials bid \$22.60 per ton for a total of \$67,800.

James Bailey made a motion to award the furnishing of 3,000 tons of I.D. wearing to York Building Products, seconded by Charles Wehrly. This motion passed.

Three bids were received for the placing of 3,000 tons of ID Wearing.
Roadite, Inc. bid \$3.92 per ton for a total of \$11,760.00
Robert Kinsley, Inc. bid \$3.79 per ton for a total of \$11,370.00
Emory Peters bid \$3.98 per ton for a total of \$11,940.00.

Charles Wehrly made a motion to award the bid to the low bidder, Robert Kinsley, Inc., seconded by James Bailey. This motion passed.

Mr. & Mrs. Ronald Flemmens were present with the subdivision plan of the George Wisner Estate property. They wish to add some land to their present lot.

James Bailey made a motion to approve the George Wisner Estate plan, seconded by Lamar Glatfelter. This motion passed..

Irvin Rappoldt gave the Zoning Officer report for the month of March. Irvin has sent letters to some residents, asking that they clean up their property. He also reported that he has not heard from the Sponheimer's regarding the letter he sent to them regarding their violation.
