

November 4, 1993

The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met in regular session on November 4, 1993 at 7:30 P.M. in the Township office. Board members present were: Lamar Glatfelter, James Bailey and Charles Wehrly. Others present were: Irvin Rappoldt, Leroy Becker, Tom Moore, Donald Bollinger, William Deal and Kelly Sanders, a York Dispatch correspondent.

Chairman Glatfelter opened the meeting with the Pledge.

The minutes were approved as written. The treasurer's report was presented to the Board members.

Leroy Becker presented the 2-lot subdivision plan of his property. This plan has met all requirements. James Bailey made a motion to approve the Becker plan, seconded by Charles Wehrly. This motion carried.

Charles Wehrly made a motion to issue a road occupancy permit to Met-Ed, seconded by James Bailey. This motion carried.

Irvin Rappoldt gave the report of building permits issued during the month of October. Mr. Rappoldt wanted to know if the Board had any objections to his issuing a home occupation permit to Steven Mintscheff for a gun shop. He was told there were no objections.

Irvin reported that the Lamar Wolfgang hearing has been scheduled for November 19 at 9:45 A.M. in the office of District Magistrate, Margaret Klinedinst.

Irvin wanted to know if he could subdivide the existing house from the property he owns along Fissel Church Road. He would like to transfer title of this property to one of the corporations he is involved with. He was told that he could bring in a plan for this subdivision.

William Deal, a certified sewage enforcement, joined the meeting to discuss his fees and to answer general questions from the Board.

Tom Moore and Donald Bollinger had some questions regarding the Gallagher property.

A combined meeting with the Supervisors and Planning Commission members was scheduled for November 18, 1993 at 7:30 P.M. for a work session. The secretary will advertise this meeting.

The bills were presented to the Board. Charles Wehrly made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Lamar Glatfelter. This motion carried.

The proposed budget for 1994 was reviewed by the Board. James Bailey made a motion to advertise the proposed budget as being available for public inspection, seconded by Charles Wehrly. This motion carried. The budget will be adopted at the December 8 meeting.

The meeting adjourned at 10:15 P.M. on motion by Charles Wehrly and second by James Bailey.
