

June 5, 1997

The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met in regular session on June 5, 1997 at 7:30 P.M. in the Township office. Board members present were: Lamar Glatfelter, James Bailey and Goldie Day. Others present were: Charles Wheat, Warren Jaasund, Henry Whitcomb, Brian Baer, Rick Sechrist, Timothy Steger, April Rehbein and Mrs. Garver.

Chairman Glatfelter called the meeting to order with the Pledge.

The minutes were approved as written.

Lamar Glatfelter made a motion to approve the Sewage Planning Module on the Kenneth & Donald Myers plan for submission to the Department of Environmental Protection. James Bailey seconded this move. The motion carried.

Irvin Rappoldt gave the report of building permits issued during the month of May. He also reported that he has asked Rob Wood of Spoutwood Farms to attend the next Planning Commission meeting to discuss the activities at the Spoutwood Farm, and to answer the complaint filed by a neighbor.

Irvin reported that he hasn't been able to contact Chris Tsakiris regarding the business he is running from his home.

Irvin has also talked to Mrs. Cleveland Thompson about cleaning up the junk on their property. The Board told Mr. Rappoldt to talk to them one more time, telling them that if they do not clean up, charges will be filed with the District Justice.

Timothy Steger gave the roadmaster report. He reported that the new road work is ready for the blacktopping, which has been promised for June 23 by Harry Brose of Roadite.


Tim also reported that more than 130 tires have been picked up from being dumped on Township roads. 69 of the tires are on wheels which must be dismounted before taking to the York County Incinerator. Once the wheels have been removed from the tires, a load will be taken for disposal at \$56.00 per ton.

Under public comments, Warren Jaasund had some comments regarding the Low Level Radioactive site being sought by the State, and Charles Wheat had some comments on items on the agenda.
