

October 2, 1997

The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met in regular session on October 2, 1997 at 7:30 P. M. In the township office. Board members present were: Lamar Glatfelter, James Bailey and Goldie Day. Others present were: Timothy Steger, John Kovach, Charles Wheat & Brian Baer.

Chairman Glatfelter called the meeting with the Pledge.

The minutes were approved as written.

Goldie Day gave the report of building permits during September. In the absence of Irvin Rappoldt, she issued 5 building permits.

The proposal from Daryl Jurkiewicz was reviewed for the contract agreement for Professional Engineering Services on Bridge #329. Mr. Jurkiewicz quoted a fee of \$1,200.00 for services to be performed. Manheim Township will be asked to pay one-half of the above amount.

Lamar Glatfelter made a motion to sign the Contract Agreement for Professional Engineering Services in the amount of \$1,200.00, seconded by James Bailey. This motion carried.

The secretary reported that she had received four quotations on de-icing salt for the winter season. Quotes were as follows:

Cargill	\$34.60 per ton delivered
Oceanport Industries	\$34.12 per ton delivered
International Sale Co.	\$39.71 per ton delivered
Rochez Bros., Inc.	\$39.56 per ton delivered

James Bailey made a motion to purchase the salt from Cargill since the Township has had satisfactory service from the company over the past. Goldie Day seconded this motion. This motion carried.

The secretary reported that the York County Association of Second Class Townships will hold the County Convention on November 6 at 4:30 P.M. Since this is a regular meeting night for the Township Supervisors the meeting night will need to be changed.

Goldie Day made a motion to change the date of the November 6th Supervisors meeting to November 5th, seconded by James Bailey. This motion carried.

Charles Wheat had some questions on the garbage contract.

Tim Steger gave the roadmaster report for September. He reported that the work on the lower building has been completed. Also, Gene Burton and Donald Young are going along with the dry hydrants.

The Board discussed road work for 1998. It was decided to motor pave Narrow Gauge Road and Sportsman Club Road with State Liquid Fuels tax monies. The Penn Dot representative will be asked to come down to write up the project application for this work.

The bills were presented to the Board. James Bailey made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Lamar Glatfelter. This motion carried.
