

December 10, 1997

The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Wednesday, December 10, 1997 at 7:30 P.M. in the Township Office. Board members present were: Lamar Glatfelter, James Bailey and Goldie Day. Others present were: Solicitor John Herrold, Melville, Jones, Marsha McKnight, Charles Wheat, Brian Baer, Douglas Crawford and correspondents from York Dispatch & York Daily Record.

Chairman Glatfelter opened the meeting with the Pledge.

The minutes were approved as written.

Douglas Crawford presented the subdivision plan of the Robert, Nancy, Ethel and Dean Beard property.

Robert and Nancy Beard wish to subdivide their mobile home and approximately two acres from the property this year. Dean Beard wishes to subdivide the original buildings and approximately 2 acres from the property in 1998. After these two subdivisions, the remaining land to the property will have to go with either Dean Beard's parcel or Robert Beard's parcel, or added to an adjoining farm. This will be by an agreement by the owners and Codorus Township. The Codorus Township Planning Commission had previously agreed on this subdivision.

James Bailey made a motion to approve the Beard plan, seconded by Goldie Day. This motion carried.

Lamar Glatfelter made a motion to approve Form B for the Beard subdivision plan, seconded by James Bailey. This motion carried.

Goldie Day made a motion to issue a renewal junkyard license to Clair Amspacher (Amspacher's Garage), seconded by James Bailey. This motion carried.

Lamar Glatfelter made a motion to re-appoint Leland Snyder to another 3-year term on the Codorus Township Zoning Hearing Board, seconded by Goldie Day. This motion carried.

Leland's new term will run from January 1, 1998 to December 31, 2000.

The proposed budget was reviewed. The secretary reported that the Township Real Estate millage rate had been reduced from .5 mills to .335 mills. A property assessed at \$100,000 would pay a tax in the amount of \$33.50 per year.

Marsha McKnight had some questions on the proposed budget.

James Bailey made a motion to approve the 1998 budget, seconded by Lamar Glatfelter. This motion carried.
